


Welcome to Convention 2006! It's all about food, fun and fellowship and not necessarily in that order. Enjoy some of the images from day 1.



This Organized Confusion was tamed by Dads Allen, Richter and Marcoux.


Pool time on Saturday is 3:00 – 4:00 pm to finish team and individual swims, plus free time for diving and such.




### Food Line Up







There were many exciting matches with everyone keeping their eyes on the ball.

Fortunately, he heard that Dad Cooper was piping at the banquet tonight and put him down.




### Chess

**Award:** Brother Jamie Dingwell earned this award through planning and hard work. Dad George Cooper and Dad Moe Linkletter presented the award.




After the awards and recess until tomorrow, the group prepared for a social event downstairs in McConnell hall.






#### Convention Sunday & Summary


